You will need to have some experience of finding out information about social care.



Your experience might be:

• Being part of a research project.



• Taking part in a survey.



• Giving your opinions in a group.



You need to live in the East of England.

What will you do?



You will:

- Tell the project team about your experiences of using social care and/or finding information about it.
